#### Why We Don't Guarantee Basic Obedience Commands?

At The Dog Services, we don't guarantee obedience commands like "sit," "stay," or "heel"—because our priority isn't performance. It's behavior change and emotional regulation.

Your dog will absolutely learn functional skills like walking calmly on leash, waiting at thresholds, and settling around distractions. But more importantly, they'll learn to think, to regulate, and to make better decisions in the real world. We teach your dog how to cope with stress, how to navigate uncertainty, and how to find safety through structure and communication.

Many programs focus on obedience alone—getting a dog to perform commands on cue—but overlook what's happening inside the dog: their nervous system, their emotions, their triggers. That kind of training can suppress symptoms without solving the root cause. We don't want a dog that just

"listens." We want a dog that understands.

That's why our focus is on long-term behavioral change, not short-term command compliance. It's also why our contract makes clear that results vary—because every dog is different, and healing isn't linear.
